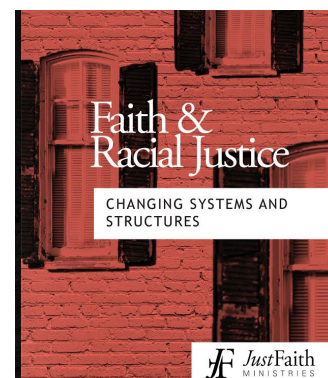

## RACIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE



Educating ourselves is a founding principle of the Visitation Racial Justice Committee (RJC); examining our history and seeking to understand the perspectives of others in intentional ways is central to our work.

The Vis RJC launched a new Just Faith study series on Monday, June 13. Eight parishioners, led by facilitators Peg Ekerdt, Karen Miller and Linda



Hughes, engage in readings, discussions and simulations to gain a better sense of how our faith and racial justice intersect. The title for this Faith and Racial Justice series indicates the focus for this study: changing systems and structures. The central text is *The New Jim Crow: Mass Incarceration in the Age of Colorblindness* by Michelle Alexander. *Just Faith* participants engaged in a racial wealth gap simulation in their first session, guided by this passage from James 1:22 - 25.

*"You must be doers of the word and not only hearers who mislead themselves. Those who hear but don't do the word are like those who look at their faces in a mirror. They look at themselves, walk away, and immediately forget what they were like. But there are those who study the perfect law, the law of freedom, and continue to do it. They don't listen and then forget, but they put it into practice in their lives. They will be blessed in what they do."*

## FINANCIAL



May Contribution Income fell short of budget by \$50,533 or 19.4%. This monthly shortfall reduced the positive variance in year-to-date contributions from \$209,077 to \$158,523. Even though contribution income took a hit this month we are still 4.06% ahead of budget.

While this represents a loss on our parish financial statements, it aligns with our year-end predictions and raises concern about alignment with our budget at the end of the fiscal year, as our expenses are over budget by 2.3% or \$107,521 for the year-to-date.

It is our sincere hope that all parishioners will be current on their 2022 pledge at the close of our fiscal year (June 30) in order to keep our contributed revenue in alignment with our budget.

Other Income, which includes ministries, program fees, miscellaneous one-time donations, school tuition, registration fees and before/after care fees exceeded budget by \$9,076 in May, bringing our Total Operating Income to a deficit of \$41,478 for the month.

Parish expenses in May were under budget but only by \$1,341 bringing our Parish Net Income to negative \$40,137 for the month.

Year -to-date Contribution and Other Income show a surplus of \$172,806. Operating Expenses are over budget by \$108,862 creating a surplus in our Year -to-date parish Net Income of \$65,286.

Compared to the prior fiscal year-to-date, parish Net Income for 2021/2022 surpassed last year's results by \$154,812. This particular positive variance, however, will fluctuate from month to month, due in part to normal contribution and expenditure timing differences.
