## RACIAL JUSTICE



Educating ourselves is a founding principle of the Visitation Racial Justice Committee (RJC); examining our history and seeking to understand the perspectives of others in intentional ways is central to our work.

The Vis RJC launched a new Just Faith study series on Monday, June 13. Eight parishioners, led by facilitators Peg Ekerdt, Karen Miller and Linda Hughes, engage in readings, discussions and simulations to gain a better sense of how our faith and racial justice intersect. The title for this Faith and Racial Justice series indicates the focus for this study: changing systems and structures. The central text is *The New Jim Crow: Mass Incarceration in the Age of Colorblindness* by Michelle Alexander. Just Faith participants engaged in a racial wealth gap simulation in their first session, guided by this passage from James 1:22 - 25.

"You must be doers of the word and not only hearers who mislead themselves. Those who hear but don't do the word are like those who look at their faces in a mirror. They look at themselves, walk away, and immediately forget what they were like. But there are those who study the perfect law, the law of freedom, and continue to do it. They don't listen and then forget, but they put it into practice in their lives. They will be blessed in what they do."
