
PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Greetings in our Lord, Jesus Christ!

On January 31 and February 1, 2026, I have asked our parish priests to participate in *Called by Name Sunday*. From all eternity God has known each one of us by name and has a particular calling for us to follow. *Called by Name Sunday* is about listening and responding to God's call.



The readings on *Called by Name Sunday* center on the theme of vocation and I have asked our priests to share their own vocation story during the homily. As you listen to the Word of God proclaimed at Mass and reflect upon the vocation story shared by your priest, please consider the following:

1. For those of you discerning your life's vocation, be open to God's call to the priesthood or religious life. God's calling is a beautiful gift; be courageous and open to His call! 



JANUARY IS HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS MONTH

“Certainly, there is a lot of ignorance on the topic of trafficking. But sometimes there also seems to be little will to understand the scope of the issue. Why? Because it touches close to our conscience; because it is thorny; because it is shameful. Then there are those at the end of the ‘supply chain’, as a user of the ‘services’ that are offered on the street or on the internet...Yes, it takes courage and honesty, when, in our daily lives we meet or deal with persons who could be victims of human trafficking, or when we are tempted to select items which may well have been produced by exploiting others. The work of raising awareness must begin at home, with ourselves, because only in this way will we be able to make our communities aware, motivating them to commit themselves so that no human being may ever again be a victim of trafficking.” Pope Francis 2018




