- # Give Alms ~ Opportunities for generosity include: Rice Bowl (benefits Catholic Relief Services) throughout the season; Catholic Relief Services Collection (overseas emergency aid) on the March 18-19 weekend; and the Good Friday Collection on April 7 (benefits Christians in the Holy Land).

## THANK YOU FROM JOURNEY TO NEW LIFE

Dear Visitation Church Social Services.

Your generosity has allowed us to do so much in supporting people on their journey to a healthier life following incarceration. We are so grateful for your contribution of \$900 given in February of 2023.

In 2022, because of donors like you, we made the following impact:

- *Emergency Assistance* 1,947 people were helped during our walk-in "welcome back" hours. Most frequent needs were identification, clothing, shoes, occupational supplies, hygiene items and backpacks.
- Residences (Journey House & Peace House) 97 persons leaving Missouri women's prisons safely landed with us to start a new life.
- **Reentry Housing Case Management** 120 people obtained housing and support through our "Housing First" model of assisting the housing of persons dealing with homelessness.
- *Employment Services* 111 returning citizens obtained one to one help to obtain and maintain employment.

We are so grateful for your support in helping those working hard to move away from past mistakes and trauma and find their inner strength "for good."

## **FINANCIAL**

January Contribution Income surpassed the budget by \$1,961, or 0.21%. This included \$529,409.35 in 2023 advance pledge payments received during the calendar year of 2022, in addition to \$405,367.09 in regular January collections, this surplus aligns with the financial patterns seen in previous years. This month's excess in contributions has reduced the year-to-date shortfall in contribution income to \$60,748 or 2.1% of budget.

Other Income, which includes ministries, program fees, miscellaneous one-time donations, school tuition, registration fees and before/after care fees exceeded budget by \$8,359 in January. Bringing our Total Operating monthly income to a surplus positive variance of \$13,561 in the month.

Parish expenses in January were under budget by 0.8% or \$3,242, creating a Parish Net Income surplus of \$13,561 for the month.
