SCHOOL OF RELIGION – REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN!

A weekly program for the children of Visitation parish, their households and their neighbors. Classes, including preparation for First Sacraments, are available for K-8th graders beginning Monday, September 11 from 5:15 – 6:15 pm.

Monday Evening Classes

School of Religion is a catechetical program that serves the children of Visitation Catholic Community and their households. We meet on Monday evenings from 5:15 – 6:15 pm. at Visitation Church. Every week opens with a 15 minute, kid-friendly prayer service followed by classes for K–8th graders. We use a lectionary-based curriculum that includes age-appropriate lessons from the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Each enrolled child also gets their own catechism booklet to take home at the end of the year.

Celebrating the Sacraments

On the first Monday of the month we celebrate God's Word with the reception of Holy Communion. During Advent and Lent, the sacrament of God's Mercy (Confession) is offered during the S.O.R. "Holy Hour." We also offer a sacramental preparation class for second and third graders who are ready for their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

Connecting with Parish Life & Loving Our Neighbors

First Mondays after class, parish households enjoy fellowship at monthly Family Dinners. Other family-friendly events throughout the year have included Advent Stations, Care Kit service projects, Christmas caroling, Stations of the Cross during Lent, a Church Treasure Hunt and May Crowning of Mary. These are perfect opportunities to invite older siblings, grandparents, godparents and neighbors into the life of your domestic church.

RIDE FOR MADRE


