



In his letter, Dr King is talking about how he is in jail for an unjust law. He wasn't even breaking a law; he was just protesting in a non-violent way. Dr. MLK Jr. wrote a letter while he was in jail, and it talks about some really important and powerful things. He talked about black people

while he was in jail, and it talks about some really important and powerful things. He talked about black people having a "wait" moment. A "wait" moment is when people tell you to wait and things will get better soon, and it doesn't get better anytime soon.

He also wrote that it broke his heart seeing little girls and boys get told that they can't go to an amusement park because of their race. This letter helped me understand better what people had to go through. I hope that this event never happens in the future; and if it does, I hope someone will be brave like Dr. MLK Jr. and it will end soon.
