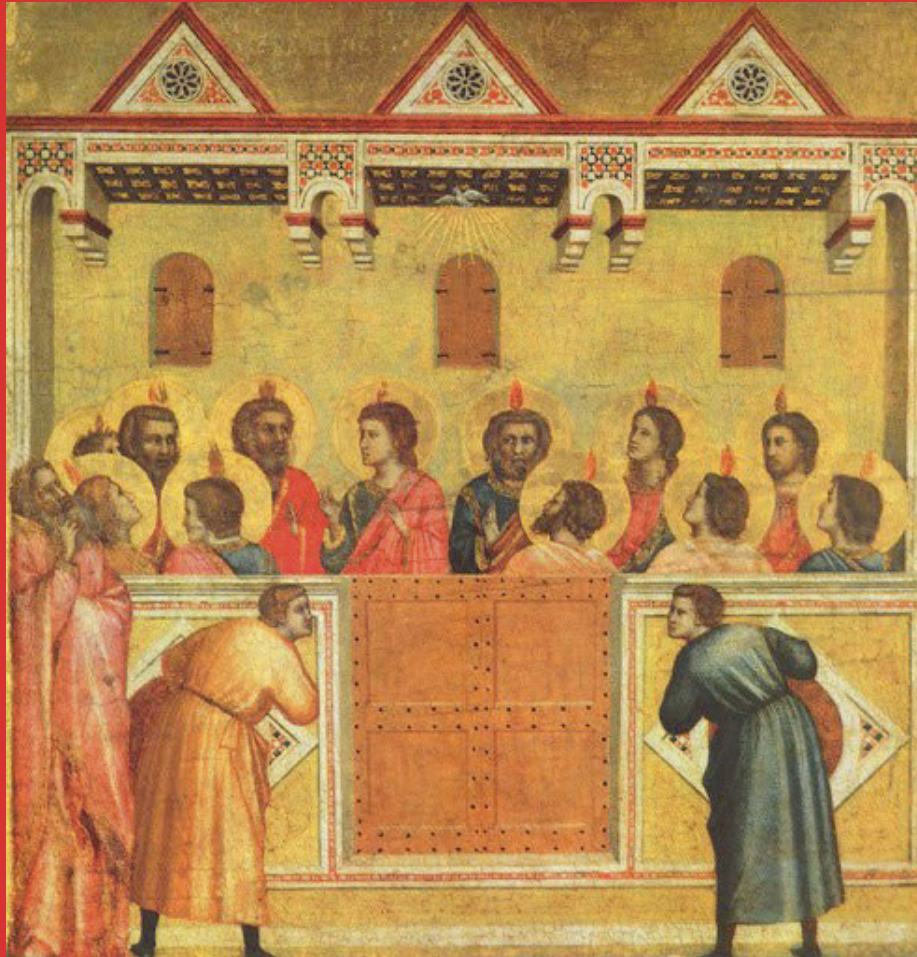

## JUST FAITH

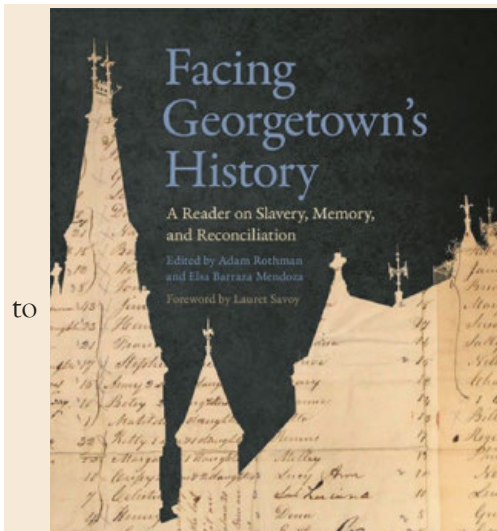
The current Just Faith Racial Healing study group has made us aware that the Kansas City Central Library (14 West 10th Street) has an exhibit on the 5th floor of the library: **Detoured: The Making of Bruce R. Watkins Drive**. It opened in March and will be there until February of 2026. It offers a great opportunity for many of us to familiarize ourselves with that story - which greatly and negatively impacted the Black community of Kansas City. It's also downtown summer activity for our young people and families.



**VIS Racial Justice Committee** will host a pot luck on June 18 - in anticipation of Juneteenth - for all Just Faith alumni (There are 65 of you among us.) We look forward to an evening of catching up on our thoughts and actions and questions about the shared work of Racial justice and awareness since last meeting.

- Thanks to all who have made contributions to our Cristo Rey Student Intern fund. We are on our way to hosting Cristo Rey interns at Visitation School again next year.

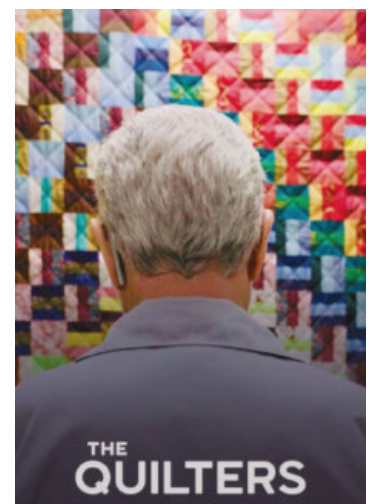


The Racial Justice Committee will host a discussion on *Facing Georgetown's History: A Reader on Slavery, Memory and Reconciliation*, edited by Adam Rothman and Elsa Barranza Mendoza, on **Tuesday, June 10 at 7:00 pm** in the Retreat Room. RJC members David Bruegging and Linda Hughes will lead the discussion of this collection of essays. Past Just Faith participants and all parishioners will have the opportunity to learn a more full version of the Catholic church's complicity with slavery, and the reconciliation process planned and implemented by Georgetown Jesuit leaders. Facilitators will also provide an update on the reconciliation process at Georgetown.

***The Quilters*** - streaming on Netflix - less than 1 hour.

*The Quilters* follows the daily lives of several quilters inside the sewing room at South Central Correctional Center, a Level 5 maximum-security prison in a small town two hours south of St. Louis, MO. From design to completion, the men reveal their struggles, triumphs and sense of pride in creating something beautiful in this windowless, sacred space deep within the prison walls. Most of the men are serving sentences from 20 years to life. It's an excellent film. Here is the trailer:\

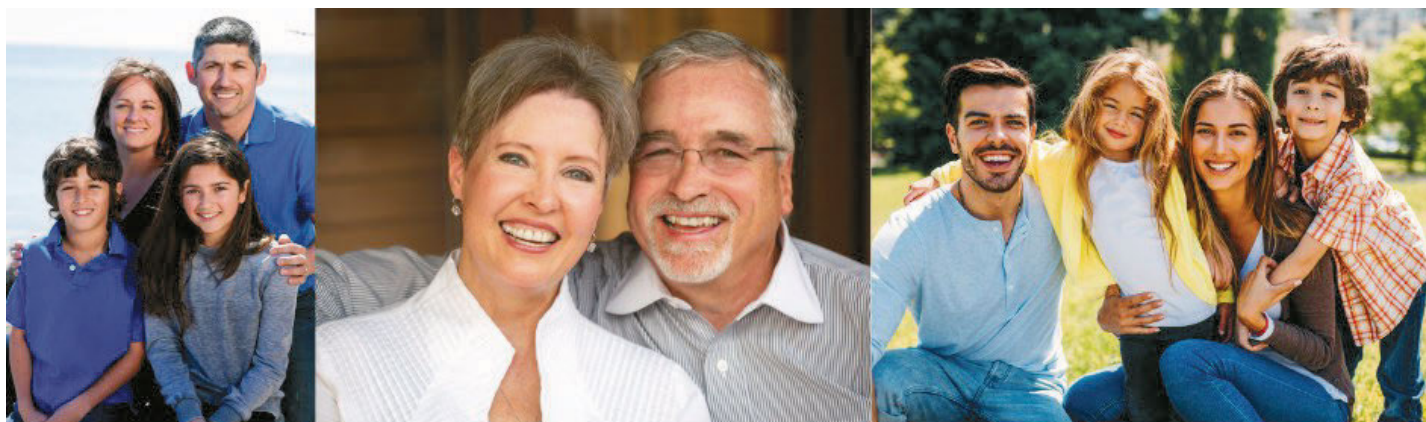
