A recent addition to our family of refugees is a single Congolese mom, named Asende. She and her children arrived in the US a few years ago, and originally settled in Michigan, but moved to Kansas City in late 2024 for a job opportunity. On June 1, she and her five children, ages 4-14, moved into a two bedroom apartment just east of downtown - and they are so happy to have a place of their own. We would love to help her furnish the apartment, so we are asking our generous community for help once again. 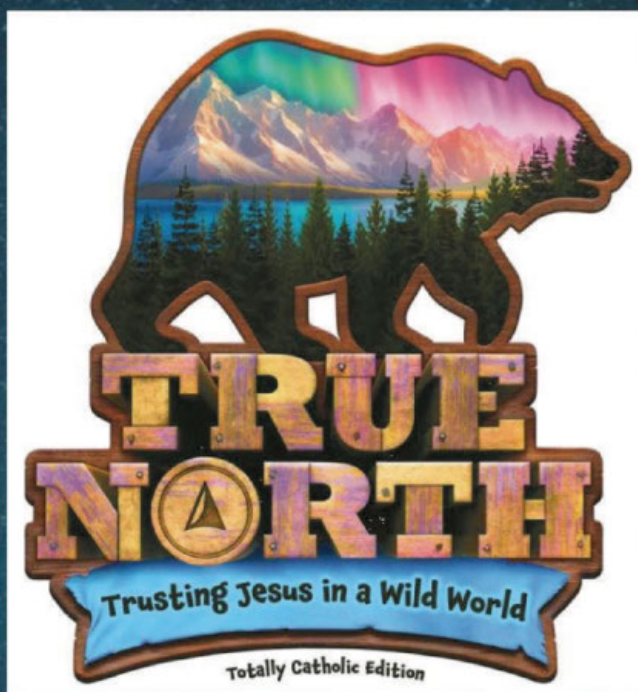
