

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

One of the options I have as a Homilist at Sunday Mass is to preach about either the readings of the day or about the Mass itself. The latter is an option I don't choose frequently enough, but beginning next week, I'll begin a 5-week homily series on the Mass. As the Source and Summit of our faith, in the words of the Second Vatican Council, teaching about the Mass deserves quality time and energy. My goal will be just to give an overview of the various sections and components of the Liturgy, and to make some connections here and there, all while keeping the talk brief enough so as to serve the liturgy and the listener. I'll also accompany it with a Pastor's Corner each week to complement the message.



I'm doing this for several reasons. First of all, we can always learn more about our faith, and this is a good opportunity for all of us, myself included, to learn and reflect together. I've also been asked to teach more about the Mass in the hope that it inspires more parishioners to join the Assembly every Sunday. If it is the Source and Summit, it deserves our best energy and dedication. I know for some of us, what I share will be very familiar. And for others of us, it might be new (and hopefully helpful). As a Eucharistic Assembly, it'll be fruitful for us to focus on the Liturgy itself in the hope of deepening our communion with God, one another and the world.
