



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

It's October! Part of me is amazed that it's already October, and part of me is amazed that it's only October. The month of September was, as always, very densely packed with activity. In some ways, September often feels like several months in one. Anyway, October arrives as always and is a favorite month for many of us, as it usually ushers in the beautiful season of fall.

October is also Respect Life month in our church. The first principle of Catholic Social Teaching is the Life and Dignity of the Human Person. Made in God's image and likeness, every human being has an inherent dignity and is worthy of reverence and respect from the first moment of life until the natural end of life.
