

Extraordinary Income is over budget by \$790,211, of which \$788,881 came from donations to the Shared VISion Capital Campaign. Extraordinary Expenses total \$52,792 for the fiscal year-to-date.

Prior Year Comparison – Compared to the same period in fiscal year 2024–2025, Contribution Income for 2025–2026 is lower by \$60,685, while Other Income is higher by \$395,443, resulting in a Total Operating Income surplus of \$334,758. Parish Expenses are higher than last year by \$194,829, producing an overall YTD budget surplus of \$139,930.




