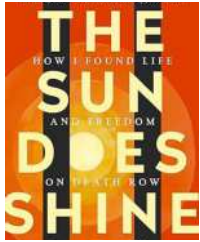

FINANCIAL

September Contribution Income fell short of budget by \$28,931 or 11.5%, as a result of timing differences in the giving patterns of our parishioners.

Other Income – which includes ministries, program fees, miscellaneous one-time donations, school tuition, registration fees, and before/after-care fees – exceeded budget by \$130,808. This favorable variance was driven primarily by the PTO's contribution to Fund a Need. As a result, Total Operating Income reflected a budget surplus of \$101,877 for the month.

Parish Expenses in September were over budget by \$10,276, primarily due to higher General Operating Expenses related to classroom and kindergarten materials. The combined effect of these factors resulted in a Parish Net Budget Surplus of \$91,601 for the month of September.

Extraordinary Income for the month of August was over budget by \$277,192, primarily due to donations received for the Shared VISION Capital Campaign. Extraordinary Expenses totaled \$52,792, which included \$24,100 for the Centegix Safety Platform and \$28,692 for K12 ITC new laptops.

Contribution Income for the year-to-date (YTD) fell short of budget by \$68,828 (9.1%). Other Income is ahead of budget by \$170,822 (56.5%), resulting in an Operating Income budget surplus of \$120,342.

Operating Expenses for the YTD are over budget by \$66,544 (4.3%), generating a Parish Net Operating budget surplus of \$53,798.

Extraordinary Income is over budget by \$790,211, of which \$788,881 came from donations to the Shared VISION Capital Campaign. Extraordinary Expenses total \$52,792 for the fiscal year-to-date.

Prior Year Comparison – Compared to the same period in fiscal year 2024–2025, Contribution Income for 2025–2026 is lower by \$60,685, while Other Income is higher by \$395,443, resulting in a Total Operating Income surplus of \$334,758. Parish Expenses are higher than last year by \$194,829, producing an overall YTD budget surplus of \$139,930.

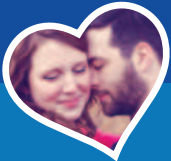

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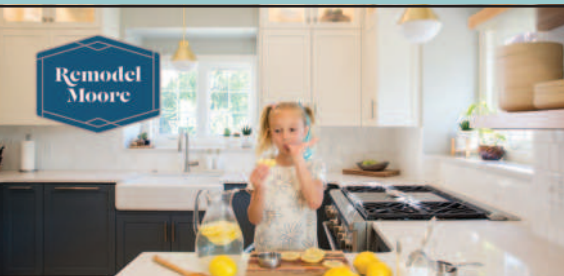
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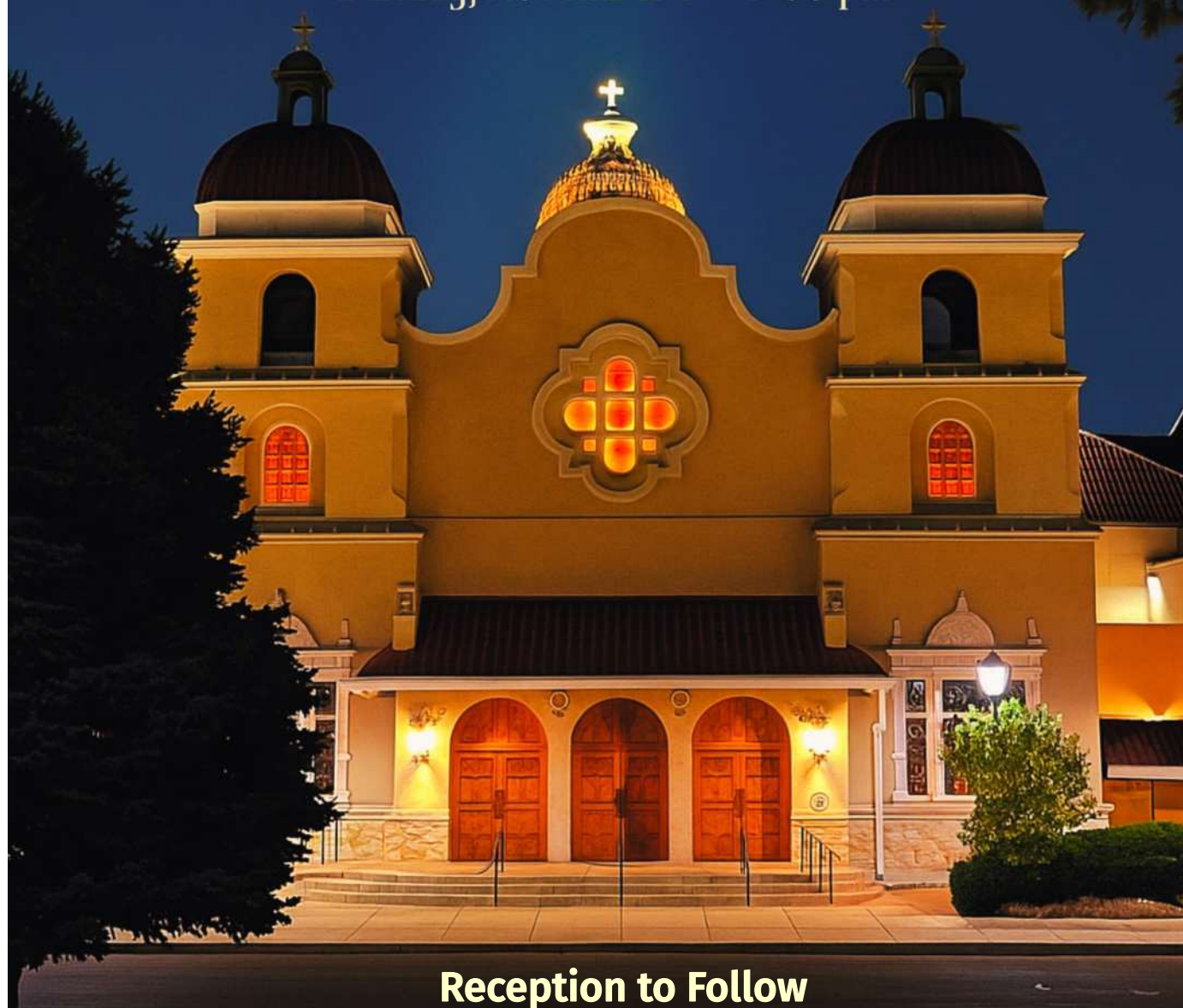
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
