PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

It's not new teaching, but in recent years, our church has begun emphasizing the spirit of Advent as preparation for God's arrival in two ways. First of course, we prepare for Christ's birth here and now, God humbly with us as a child, the Word Made Flesh dwelling among us. That arrival captures our hearts and minds so powerfully and beautifully through stories, images and carols. And rightly so. The Incarnation is one of the central mysteries of our faith, and Advent helps us express our longing for God With Us here and now. But a second arrival gives Advent another dimension: the Second Coming of Christ, when the work of salvation is complete and all that God has promised is fulfilled. The Second Coming is a more foreboding mystery and much harder to appropriate. It conjures fear and leaves us grasping for context. It's challenging to fathom, imagine or even desire the Second Coming of Christ. But Advent invites us to ponder it, wait for it and even look forward to it all the same.



From where I sit this year, it is strangely consoling to reflect on the Second Coming. The completion of things. The final victory of good over evil. The ultimate and unqualified reconciliation of the eternal and the finite, divine and human, God With Us and Us With God. Trying to imagine it, trying to find myself in it, trying to "look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come" as we profess every Sunday is a tremendous leap of faith. But Advent tells us that it's a leap toward something good, all for which we long: final union with God. It's definitely worth pondering.

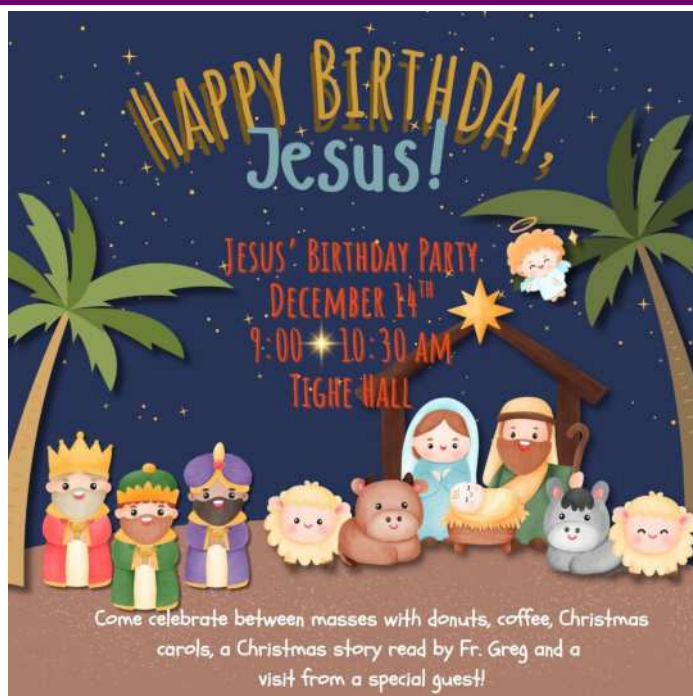

1935 -The equality of men rests essentially on their dignity as persons and the rights that flow from it: Every form of social or cultural discrimination in fundamental personal rights on the grounds of sex, race, color, social conditions, language, or religion must be curbed and eradicated as incompatible with God's design.
