As we heard once more that "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere" we were also asked if "We will be extremists for hate, or will we be extremists for love?" It is a question to embrace each moment of each and every day.

Our deepest thanks to the readers who powerfully conveyed Dr. King's words: Marie Effertz, Jenny Evett, Will Fanning, Kara Farren, Michael Garrett, Tighe Greenhalgh, Fr. Greg Haskamp, Melissa Lising and Mark Thompson; to our cantors, Cathy Colburn, David Ekerdt and Charlie Tietjen; to the Visitation faculty and Dianne VanBallas in particular, whose encouragement brought her students and their parents to the evening; to each of you who braved the cold and gave up the first half of the Indiana -Miami game; to George Hans whose piano brought the music of the Black church to each moment of reflection; and to Tim McCray whose direction brings the gravitas that the event deserves.

"God weaver of humanity, show us how to robe ourselves in Dr. King's words. May we become women and men whose words and actions give rise to a world free of hatred and oppression."

Following the Letter from a Birmingham Jail Prayer Service, Visitation School eighth graders presented document summaries to third and fourth grade students.

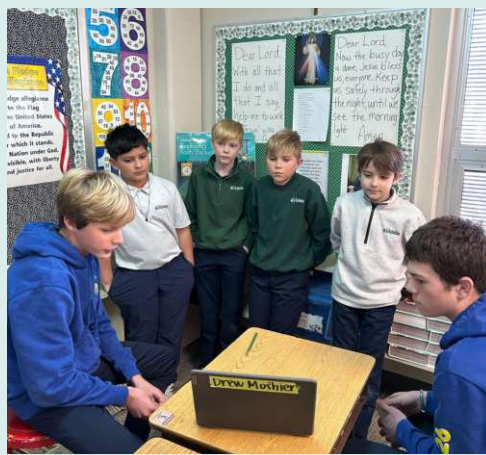


