FINANCIAL

Once again this year, we have employed a 3-year average of contributions received for budgeting. As last year's actual contribution income exceeded our budget projections for 2021/2022, the average this year has increased 1.6% from \$4,153,301 to \$4,280,154 in 2022/23. With regard to parish expense budgets, this year's projections were a little higher to account for the current inflation rate. Also they included a salary increase for all staff members for both church and school. Ultimately, we were able to submit a balanced budget to the Diocese of \$5.25 million for the 2023/2023 fiscal year.

August 2022 Contribution Income fell short of budget by \$42,134 or 15.5%. Other Income, which includes Ministries, Program Fees, Miscellaneous one-time Donations, School Tuition, Registration Fees and Before/After Care Fees exceeded budget by \$17,366 in August, bringing our Total Operating Monthly income to a deficit of \$24,767

Year -to-Date Contribution and other Income shows a deficit of 52,480. Operating Expenses were under budget by \$55,524 creating a surplus in our YTD Parish Net Income of \$3,044. Compared to the prior fiscal year to date, Parish Net Income for 2022/2023 surpassed last year's results by \$66,474.

Something that makes Catholic Charities of Kansas City-St. Joseph unique, is we walk alongside every mother in need. Whether she chooses adoption or to parent, we have Family Development Specialists here to help. For more information on our Mom's Empowerment Program (Pregnancy through baby's first birthday) use the QR Code to the right.



BIRTHFATHERS

- ◆ Birthfathers have legal rights that are equally considered. They are provided legal representation, information and counseling if requested that culminates in their termination of parental rights and consent to adoption.
- ◆ Involved Birthfathers may also receive updates of photos and letters from the adoptive family just as the Birthmother receives hers.

- ◆ If a Birthmother is uncertain as to the status of the father, lawyers will work with her to make sure all necessary legal courses of action are taken for a successful adoption to occur and the agency will be there to support that work.

TYPES OF ADOPTIONS

- ◆ Closed Adoption—Birthmother does not wish to have contact with adoptive family or the child she places. We still require the adoptive family to submit pictures and letters for the first year, should the Birthmother desire them even years later.
- ◆ Semi- Open Adoption—Birthmother chooses the family and may meet them. First names are known and non-identifying information. Any correspondence or get-togethers are facilitated through the agency. This sometimes transitions into an open adoption.
- ◆ Open Adoption—Birthmother wishes to have an ongoing relationship with the adoptive family, last names and contact information can be exchanged. The agency can help facilitate or both are also able to contact one another directly.



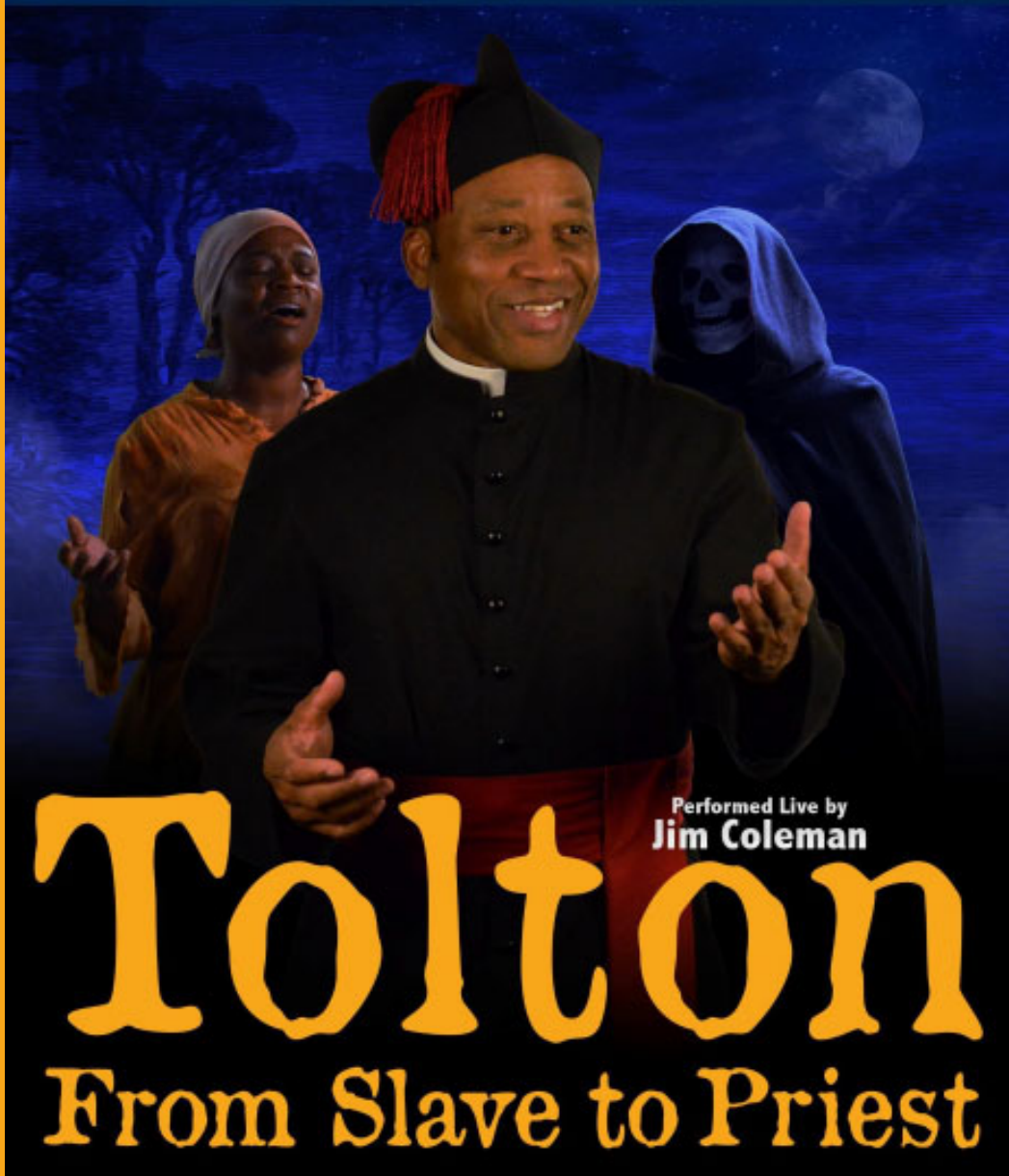
