RACIAL JUSTICE



The parish Racial Justice Committee is happy to share some of the comments of our Visitation 7th graders who attended the parish's January 16 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. prayer service. There were so many insightful and wise comments that we will share more next week. Thanks to Mrs. VanBallas for sharing the work of her students.

Dear Racial Justice Committee.....:

"For example, there was one part in (Dr. King's) letter that was talking about how a little girl couldn't go to an amusement park just because of the color of her skin. Or when you couldn't even sleep in a motel, and just had to sleep in your car. It's crazy how much people used to separate you from them just based on what someone would look like...."

"Thank you for putting on this presentation. I really enjoyed listening to the song, prayers and speech. After going to this service I believe I could do a better job turning 'nobodyness' in a 'somebodyness.' Overall I learned a lot and thought you all did a wonderful job!"

"I found it fascinating that the message that Dr. King delivered sixty years ago is still so relevant and moving in today's world. It inspired me to ..speak out against injustice ... I hope that you will have this service again so even more people can experience the power of Dr. King's words."

RACISM AND OUR FAITH

AN EVENING OF CONVERSATION

On January 26, parishioners from Visitation, St. Monica, St. Therese Little Flower and St. Elizabeth met at Visitation to continue the conversation about Racism and Our Faith.

The focus of the evening's discussion was Catholic education and the proposed Montessori school that will move in the fall of 2023

from Kansas City, Kansas to the campus of St. Therese Little Flower. Jeremy Lillig, director of the diocesan Bright Futures Fund was in attendance and able to answer questions about this new endeavor. It is the hope of all in attendance that this school will offer the opportunity for Catholic education to Catholic families in underserved areas of the city. At the same time, participants asked that those who are affected by such plans are consulted before and during the planning and implementation.



The next Conversations event is scheduled for April 13 at St. Monica.

DEATH PENALTY - PRAYER VIGIL FEBRUARY 7

On August 2, 2018, the Vatican announced that it had formally changed the official Catechism of the Catholic Church on the death penalty calling capital punishment “an attack on the inviolability and dignity of the person” and deeming it “inadmissible” in all cases.

On Tuesday, February 7 at 5:30 pm in the St. Joseph Chapel, we will hold a prayer vigil for Leonard Rayheem Taylor who is scheduled to be executed by our state.



FEAST OF ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA FEBRUARY 8TH – PATRONESS OF SURVIVORS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Who is St. Josephine Bakhita? Born into a wealthy family, she was 7 years old when she was kidnapped by slave traders and sold into slavery. She endured great suffering at the hands of her captors but eventually was sold to a family where she was treated with more kindness. At the age of 21, she was exposed to the faith through a brief stay with the Canossian Sisters of the Institute of the Catechumens in Venice. It was there she was introduced to the faith and eventually received the Sacraments. When her captors came back to retrieve her, she begged them to allow her to stay with the sisters. Her wish was granted and she was consecrated to God on December 8, 1896. For 50 years she served the poor with great care and compassion until her death in 1947.

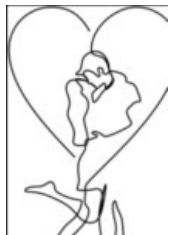

YOGA AT VIS

Gentle Hatha, Mondays 8:30 am - In this class we blend breath and movement with an emphasis on alignment. Students build endurance and strength while improving flexibility.
