Visitation School Staff – Research findings


"The inability to have break out spaces that can support different types of activates simultaneously."

"It is a challenge to set up for labs, I can't use the cafeteria except on half days because there are lunches in the middle of my class."

"The cabinets are high and require a chair to reach."

"We need to consider how best to provide engaging learning opportunities and spaces to support them. We need to build and plan for flexibility so that we are not locked into a single purpose or use or model. Catholic education has succeeded for many years by being flexible enough to make learning work despite challenges of space and resources."



Existing Site Plan








Parking Efficiency




Parking Efficiency – Shift North








Ground Floor Plan






Addition Option 1


- > ECC on main level, with separate entry
- ECC Outdoor Play Adjacent to ECC
- ➤ Kitchen in Addition
- ➤ 6th-8th space identity
- > + 3,029 square foot of Storage



Addition Option 2

- ➤ Kitchen in Addition on lower level with Alley access
- ➤ Maximized K-8th without ECC
- > 7th-8th Experience Adjacent to Media Hub
- > + 2,711 square foot of Storage


